The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed and subsequently approves the requested amendment to the FY 2024-2028 Missouri State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to incorporate Amendment #5 of the St. Louis Metropolitan Area (EWG) FY 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of May 1, 2024.

The East-West Gateway Council of Governments (EWG) Board of Directors approved the Highway Only TIP Amendment #5 on April 24, 2024. The Missouri Governor has designated signature authority for the duration of term to Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) on March 14, 2024. MoDOT has approved the EWG FY2024-2027 Highway Only TIP Amendment #5 based on that authority.

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.218(b), FHWA has determined that this TIP and STIP amendment is based on a transportation planning process that substantially meets the requirements of 23 U.S.C 134 and 135, 49 U.S.C. 5303 and 5304 and 23 CFR 450 Subparts A, B, and C.
