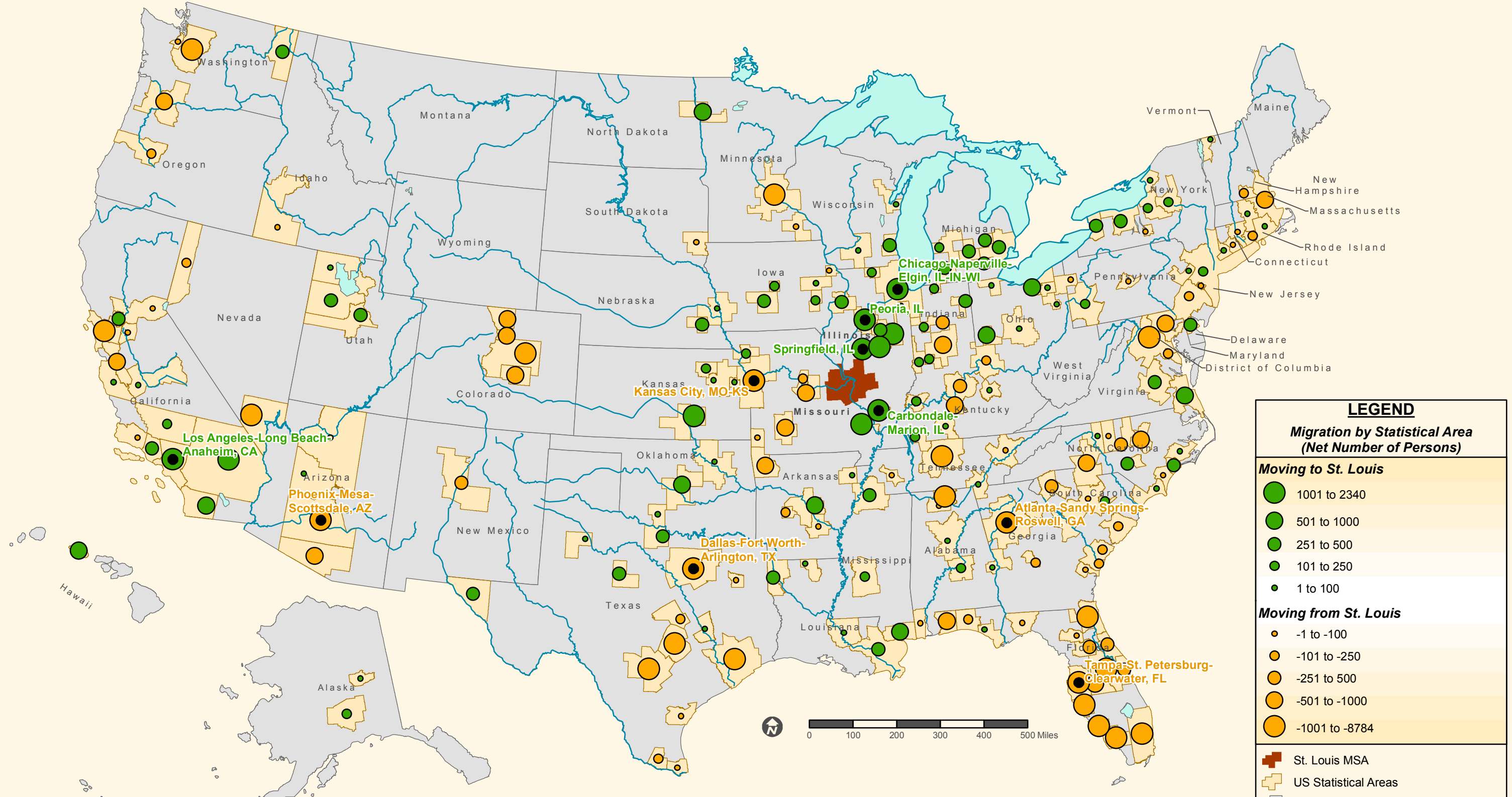


Domestic Migration to and from the St. Louis Region, 1992-2011
