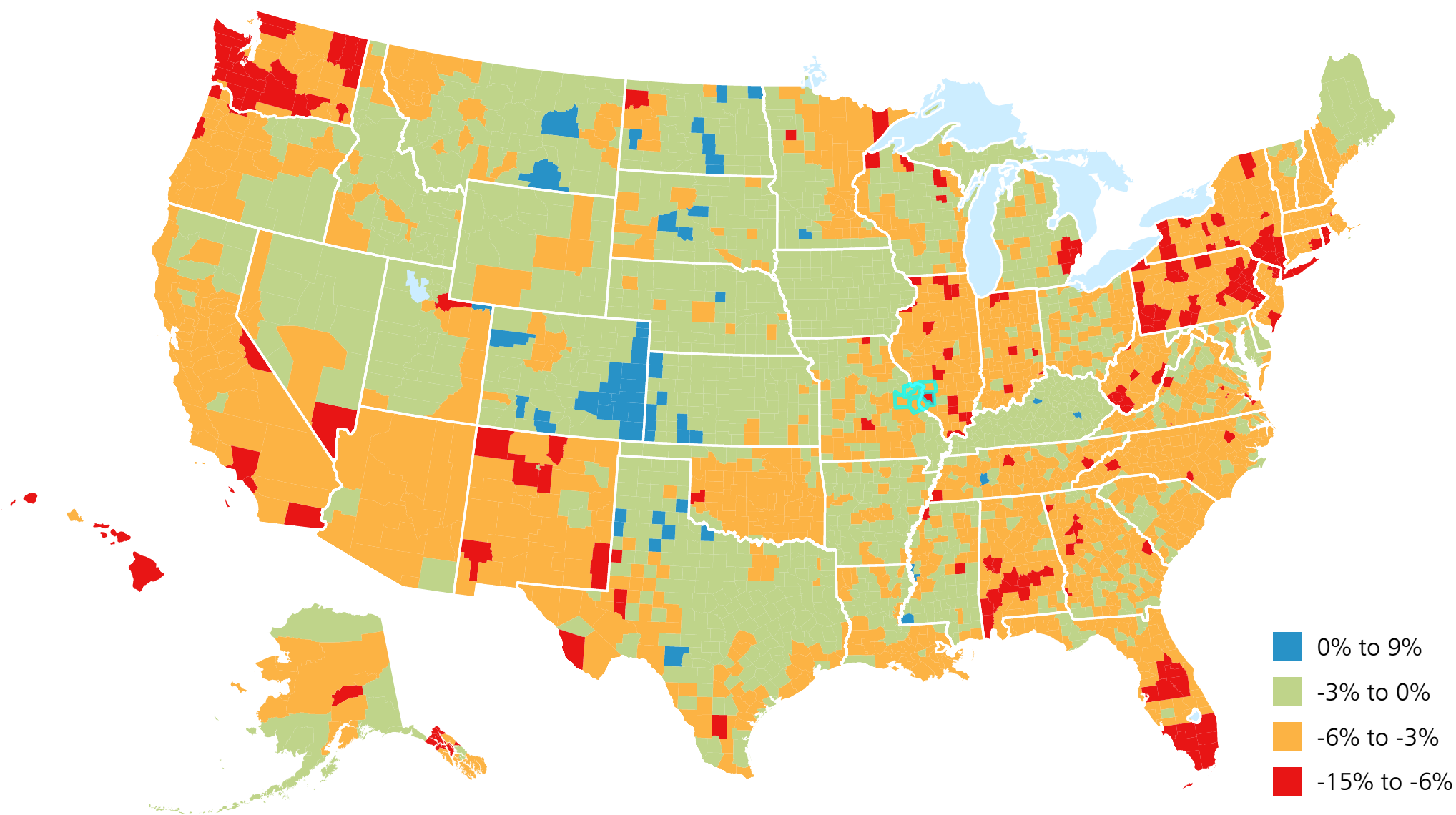
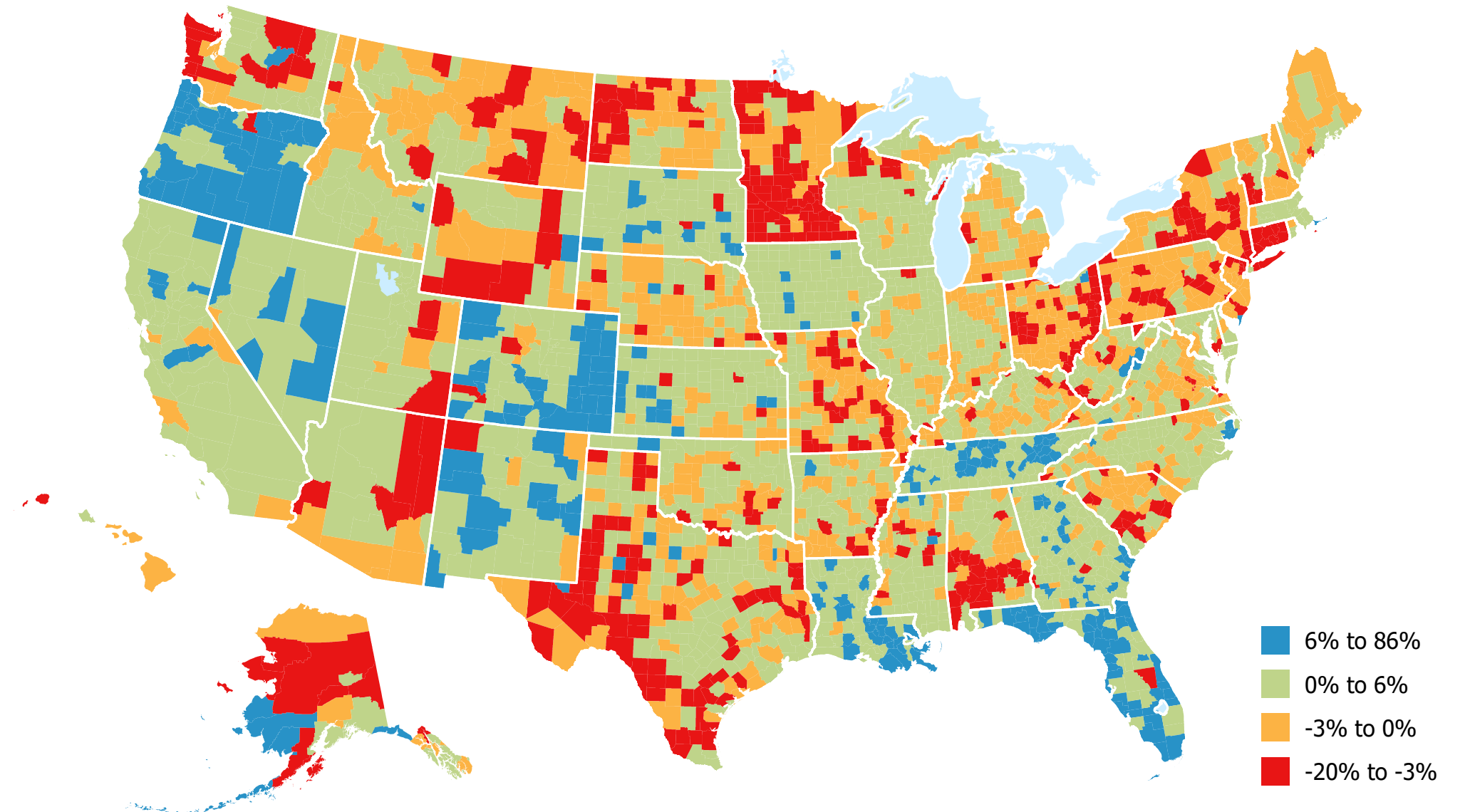


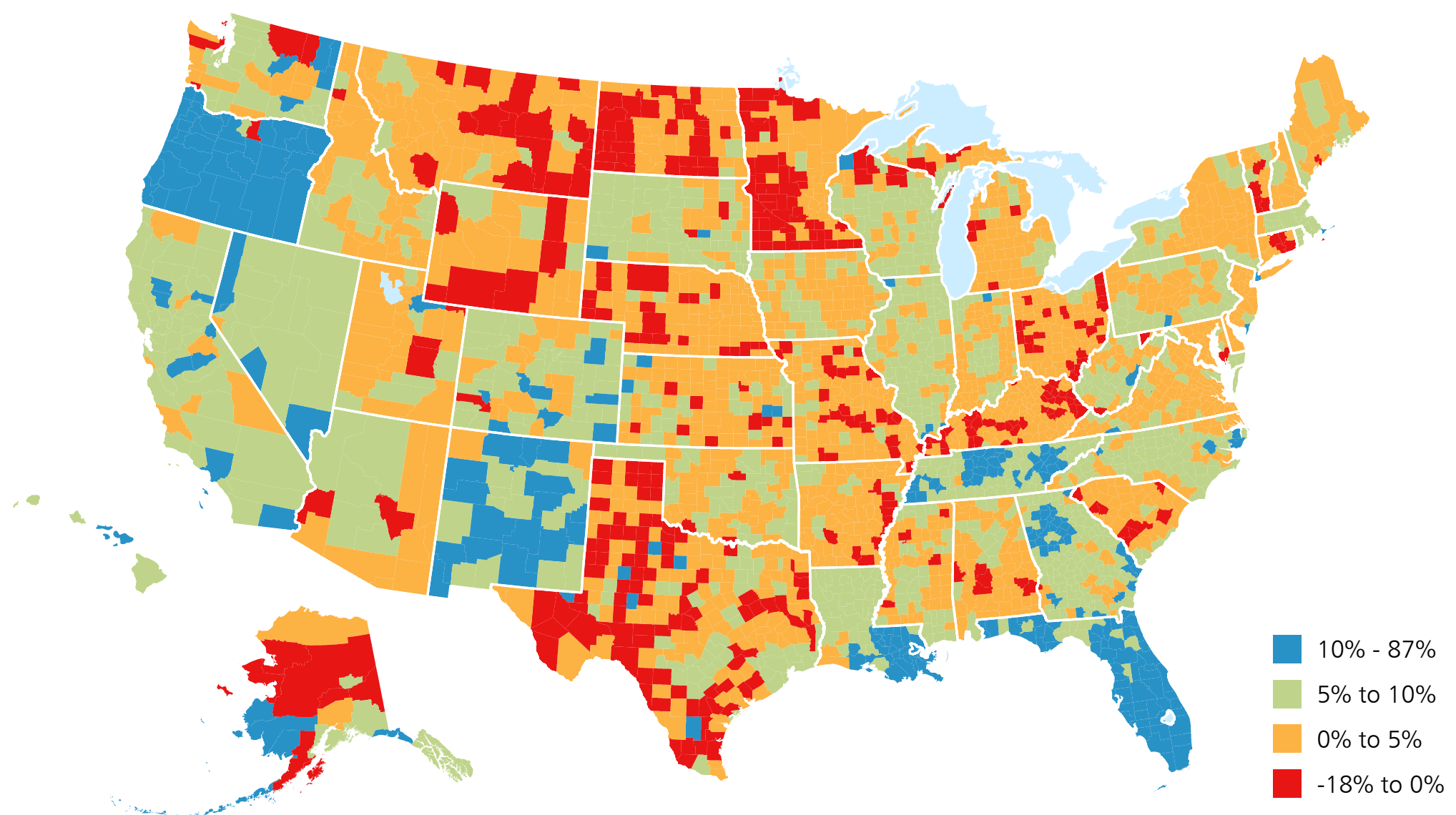
Change In Unemployment Rate



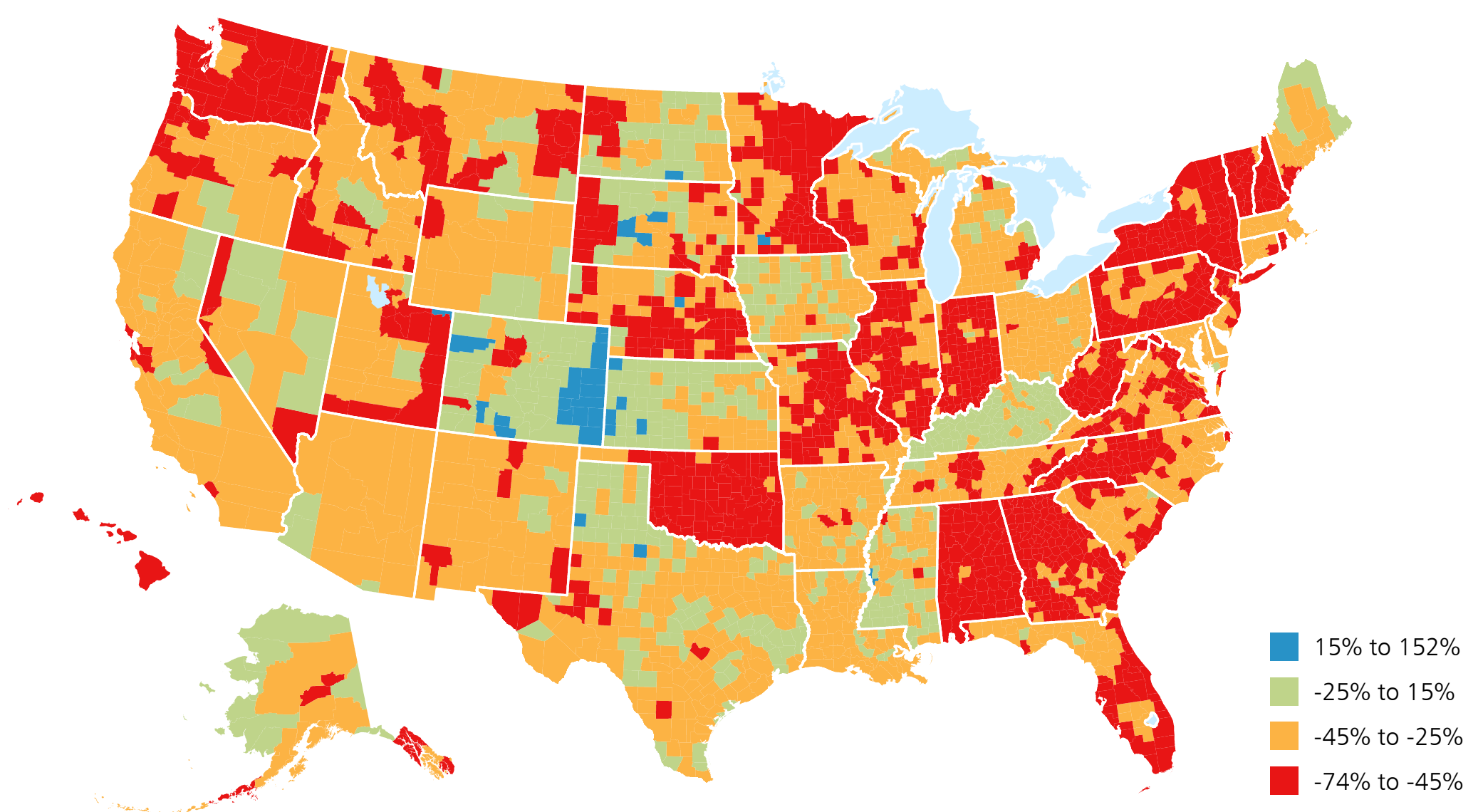
Percent Change Total Labor Force

This map depicts the non-seasonally adjusted employment statistics by county for the entire United States for the months of July 2020 and July 2021. Opening up after COVID restrictions, the East-West Gateway region saw its unemployment rate fall by about 4.2% over the year, along with a 3.2% gain in the total labor force and 3.2% gain in the employed labor force. The number of unemployed persons reduced by 49.3%.
