The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has reviewed and approved the requested amendment to the FY 2024-2028 Missouri State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) to incorporate the St. Louis Metropolitan Area (EWG) FY 2024-2027 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), as further described in your letter of October 23, 2023.

The East-West Gateway Council of Governments (EWG) Board of Directors approved the Highway Only TIP amendment on September 27, 2023. The Missouri Governor approved the EWG FY2024-2027 Highway Only TIP amendment on October 18, 2023.



The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT) have requested to amend the FY 2024-2027 TIP, *Connected 2050*, and the related Air Quality Conformity Determination. In all, they are requesting to add one new project, modify one project, and add one new scoping project. This memo outlines the requested changes.

Missouri New Project

MoDOT is requesting to add a project to make structural repairs to the eastbound I-70 bridge over the Missouri River and I-64 from Leonor K. Sullivan to 22nd Street.
