Public Transportation Safety Goal

Improve the safety of public transportation systems

Requires public transportation operators to develop and implement safety plans

Manages the safety hazards and safety risks within transit systems

Develop and implement PTASP and safety targets

Use a data-driven approach to develop the PTASP and targets

Review/revise PTASP and safety targets annually

Must include a safety management system framework

Must include procedures for identifying, mitigating, and monitoring safety risks
