## **PEI Determination Request Form**

East-West Gateway Council of Governments (EWG) utilizes a Population and Employment Index (PEI) to determine the geographic scale for road and bridge project types. Projects that are 'within community' emphasize safe, multimodal connections and access to community resources. Projects that are 'outside community' emphasize mobility to ensure the region is well connected. This enables project evaluation to vary across each scale, with multimodal improvements and regional transportation significance (i.e., functional classification) weighted by level of significance for each scale. Projects categorized as 'within community' have a higher population and employment density (PEI of 1.45 or greater). Projects with a PEI less than 1.45 are categorized as 'outside community.'

Project applicants can request the project's PEI categorization prior to final application submittal. Requests must be submitted to EWG staff at <a href="mailto:stps@ewgateway.org">stps@ewgateway.org</a> by January 18, 2024. EWG staff will respond within five business days of the request.
