# Laws Governing Air Pollution

## Federal

- 40 CFR 61 Subpart M – EPA’s National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants Regulation
- 29 CFR 1910.1001 – OSHA’s General Industry for asbestos
- 29 CFR 1926.1101 – OSHA’s Construction Industry for asbestos

## State

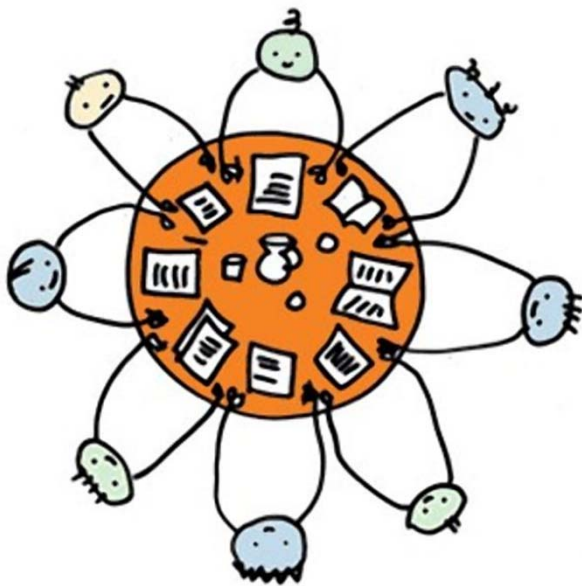
- 10 CSR Subpart 10-6.220-250 –  
Missouri Department of Natural Resources Air Quality Standards regarding asbestos

## Local

- Ordinance 71332 – City of St. Louis Ordinance



# Air Pollution Control – History



- City Ordinance 70607 passed on July 19, 2017
- A memorandum of agreement was submitted for review with MDNR and approved November 1, 2019 – September 30, 2021
- Two Air Pollution Inspector positions were posted on the City’s website
- Air Pollution Inspectors manage notifications, inspections and reporting to MDNR

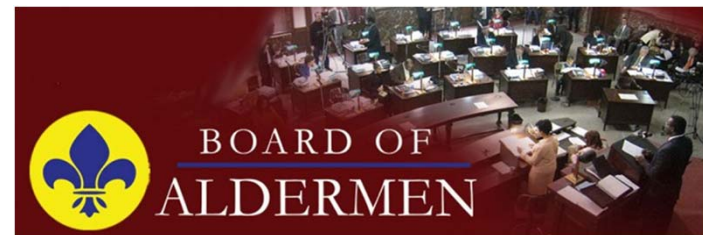



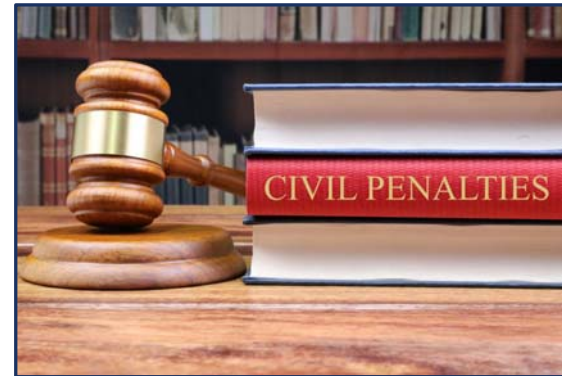
## ALL notifications MUST be entered

- Easy online payment
- Real-time uploads & status
- Shared with State
- Shared with Building Division
- Building permit Check-in
- Complete record of building history



# Air Pollution Control – Fine process

- If an issue is noted by the APCP  
**Notice of Violation**
- Unresolved violations will result in fines
- Unpaid fines will lead to a Municipal court summons
- Unpaid fines will also block future notifications
