The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) and local Illinois sponsors have requested to amend the FY 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), *Connected 2050*, and the related Air Quality Conformity Determination to add seven new projects and modify seven projects.

**Illinois New Projects**

IDOT has requested to add five new projects on behalf of local Illinois sponsors to the FY 2025-2028 TIP. Edwardsville and America’s Central Port have each requested to add one new project to the FY 2025-2028 TIP. Funding for these projects was awarded by the USDOT following a nationwide solicitation for Rebuilding America’s Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) grants. Funding for the Fairview Heights, Lebanon, Mascoutah, and Millstadt projects was awarded by IDOT following a statewide solicitation for Safe Routes to School (SRTS) projects.
